MAY PROGRAM: FIELDS OF COLOR WITH INTARSIA

Last month our new Guild member Mary Beth K. demonstrated for us the many different Short Row methods available. I liked her swatching, encouraging us to just try the different methods and see which one we like without a project commitment; just explore and experiment. Thank you, Mary Beth! For May, we will once again have Mary Beth provide our Program, and this time she will cover Intarsia. Originally a woodworking technique, the knitting version creates fields of different colors laid next to one another, like fitting together pieces of a jigsaw puzzle. I personally have never tried it, so am excited to learn this new knitting skill. She has mentioned it is very easy; we will see. If you like to learn with your hands, bring some yarn in two or more colors and needles of appropriate size and she will help guide you through the technique.
