To bring to class:

Light smooth Worsted weight yarn in two or more colors and appropriate needles size (6,7,8) straight or circular, crochet hook size H. Bring scissors and yarn needle.

Printed handout is provided and bring pencil or pen and paper to take notes if you like.



## Homework

Using smooth, light-colored worsted weight yarn and a size H (5.5mm) hook, make one crocheted square, as follows:

### Simple crocheted square

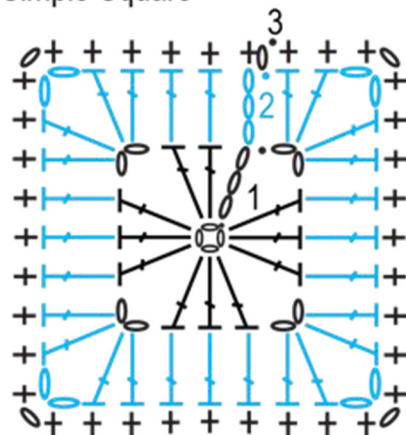
Ch 4, join with slip st to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, ch 2, \*3 dc in ring, ch 2; rep from \* two times, join with slip st to top of ch-3.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 2 dc, \*(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next space\*\*, dc in next 3 dc; rep from \* around, ending last rep at \*\*, join with slip st to top of ch-3.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, sc in each dc around, placing (sc, ch 1, sc) in each corner space, join with slip st to first sc. Fasten off.

### Simple Square

- o chain (ch)
- + single crochet (sc)
