



## **C2C / Corner to Corner Crochet**

A textured stitch suitable for dishcloths, baby blankets

Start at corner and work on the diagonal increasing each row, until desired length.

Then decrease on each row.

**Stitches:** chain, slip stitch and double crochet.

**Instructions increasing:** Chain 6. Work DC (double crochet) into 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> chains from hook. One tile made.

Chain 6. Work DC (double crochet) into 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> chains from hook.

\*Flip work, the slip stitch into 3 chain space of first tile. Work 3 chain then 3 DC into this space.

Slip stitch into next 3 chain space. Work 3 chain then 3 DC into this space.

At end of row work 6 chain, then work DC into 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> chains from hook.

Repeat from \* until work is desired size.

**Instructions decreasing:** At end of row, DO NOT work 6 chain. Flip work and work 3 slip stitches across 3 DC to 3 chain space. Then 3 chain and 3 DC into space.
